Event Rules

1. Signed Vendor Application and Hold Harmless Agreement must be turned into the Executive Director 2 days prior to the festival. The Executive Director holds the right to make exceptions to this rule on a case-by-case basis.
2. Set up starts at 3:30 with the event beginning at 5:00. No set-ups will be allowed after 4:30 PM. You have 1 hour to remove your items and clean up after the market closes. Please notify the Executive Director at least 48 hours before the next event if you need to cancel.
3. Spaces are assigned by the Executive Director. Vendor consideration will be on a case by case basis. Downtown Association members will receive top priority.
4. BID and KDA members are open to sell items pertaining to their business or made/grown in Montana, on a case-by-case basis.
5. All other market vendors may only sell items authorized by the Executive Director.
6. The Festival does not provide setup supplies. Vendors provide their own tables and amenities.
7. All baked goods must be produced from a certified kitchen or have health department authorization.
8. Food vendors must be fully contained to operate on their own accord. **“QUIET” generators only will be allowed** so not to disturb the attendees and other vendors. (No electricity is available).
9. Canopies shall be weighted for safety on all four legs. Umbrellas shall be securely weighted and fastened for safety. Weight shall be sufficient enough to withstand strong winds.
10. For safety reasons all vehicles must park off premise. Any vehicle in the event area will be at the discretion of the Executive Director, on a case-by-case basis.
11. Vendors shall bring no dogs into the event area.
12. All scales, if used, must be licensed and inspected annually by the Bureau of Weights & Measures.
13. The Executive Director will enforce these rules. Vendor disputes beyond the scope of the Executive Director will go before the KDA Board.
14. Vendors must possess all required permits and licenses if required by the State of Montana and/or the City of Kalispell and/or Flathead City/County Health Department and shall follow all State and local statutes, rules and regulations.

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
